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The Office of Institutional Effectiveness, Planning and Research is pleased to present the 2023-24 Middle Tennessee State University Fact Book.

The book is an annual publication intended as a single, readily accessible, consistent source of information about Middle Tennessee State University. It is a summary of institutional data gathered from various sources, compiled to capture the 2023-24 Academic Year. In some instances, multiple years of data are provided for a historical prospective. Enrollment data is extracted from 14th day tables.

First-time freshmen cohort data is cited in several sections of the fact book. This cohort is defined as first-time degree-seeking freshmen who started in the fall or prior summer. Effective with the 2018-19 edition of the fact book, all prior summer start freshmen were added to the first-time freshmen cohort.

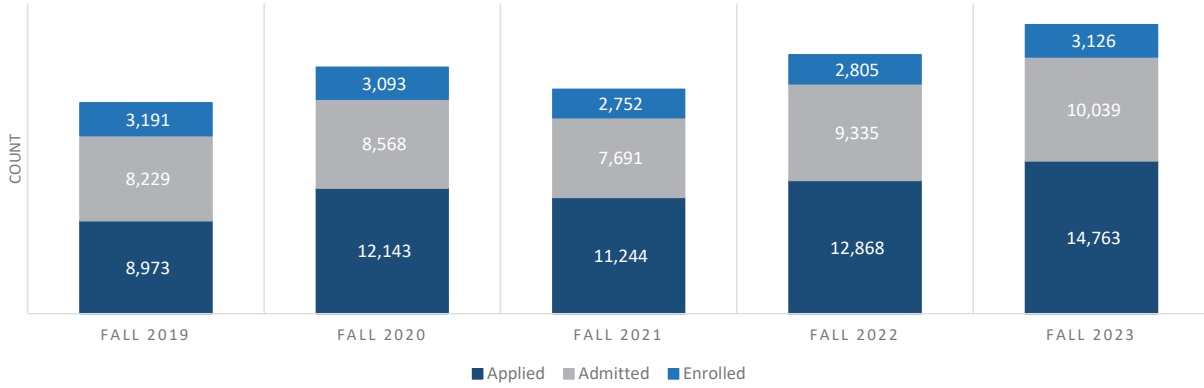

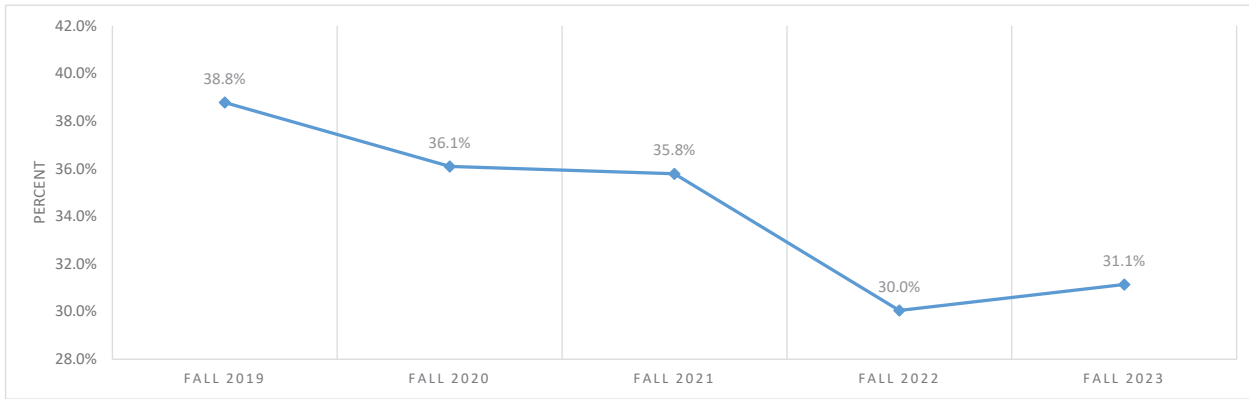

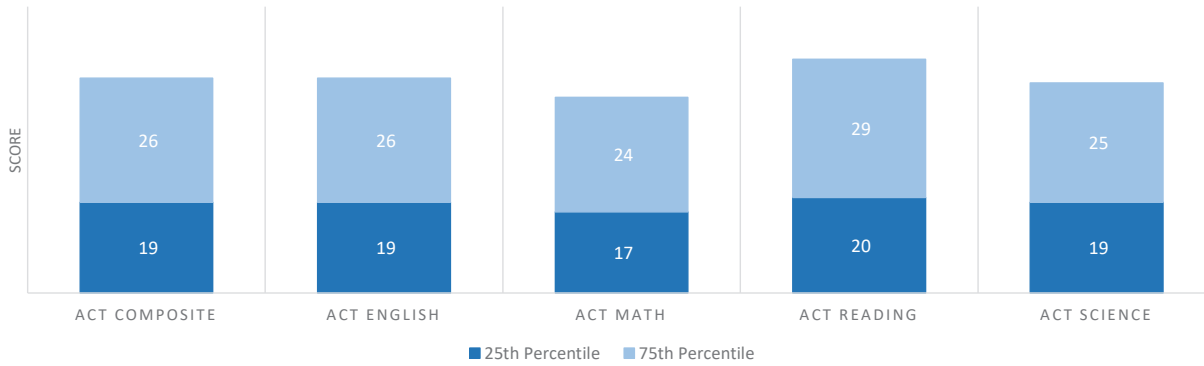
**New Freshmen Applied, Admitted and Enrolled**

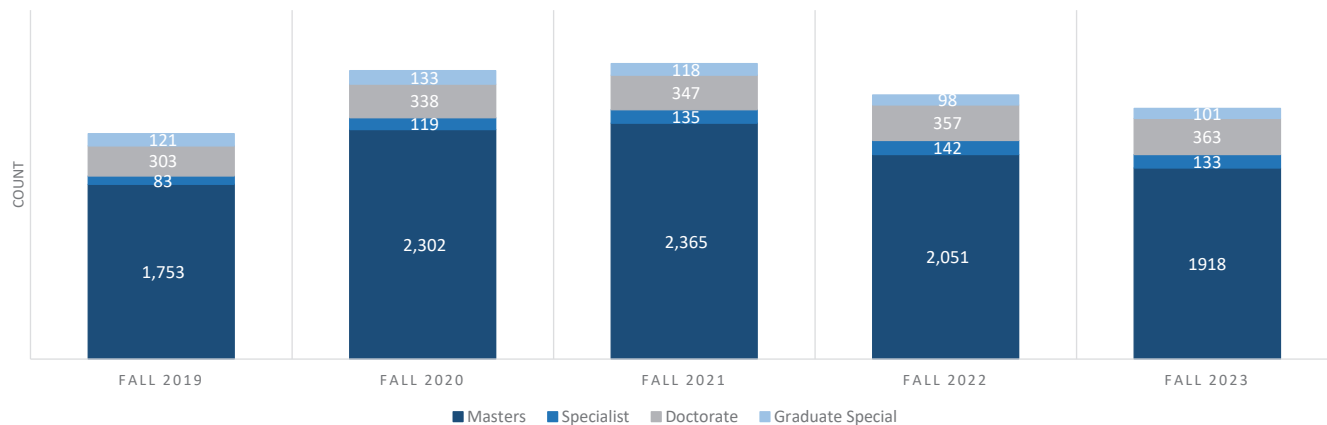

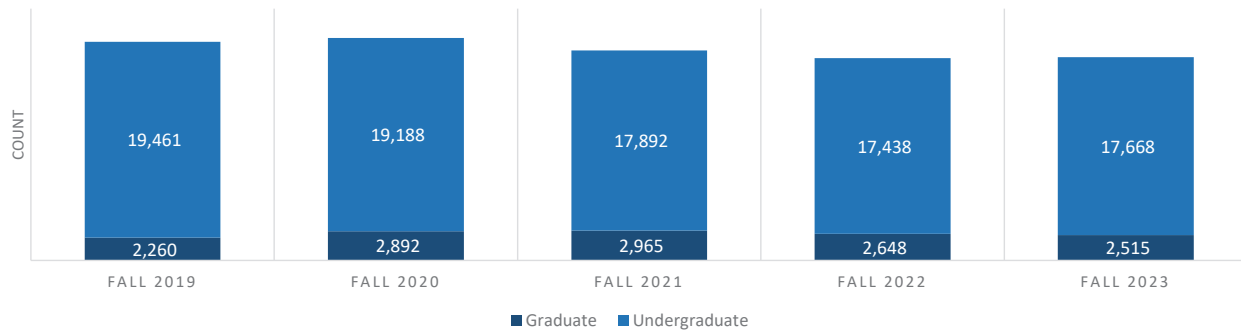

### Graduate Headcount by Classification

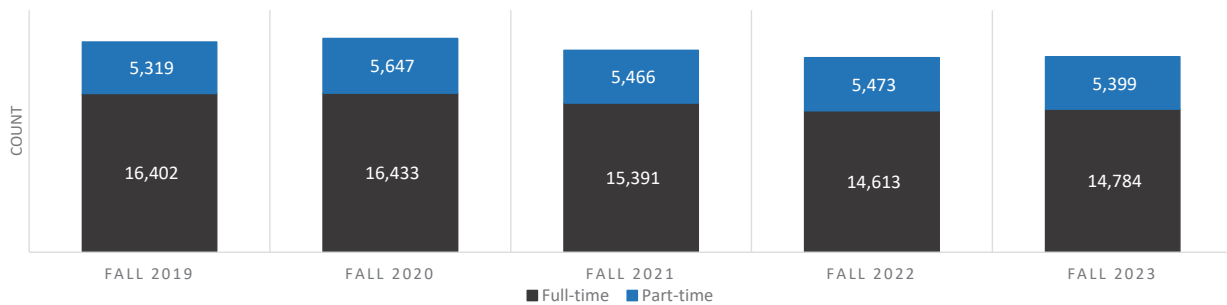

### Total Fall Headcount by Enrollment Status



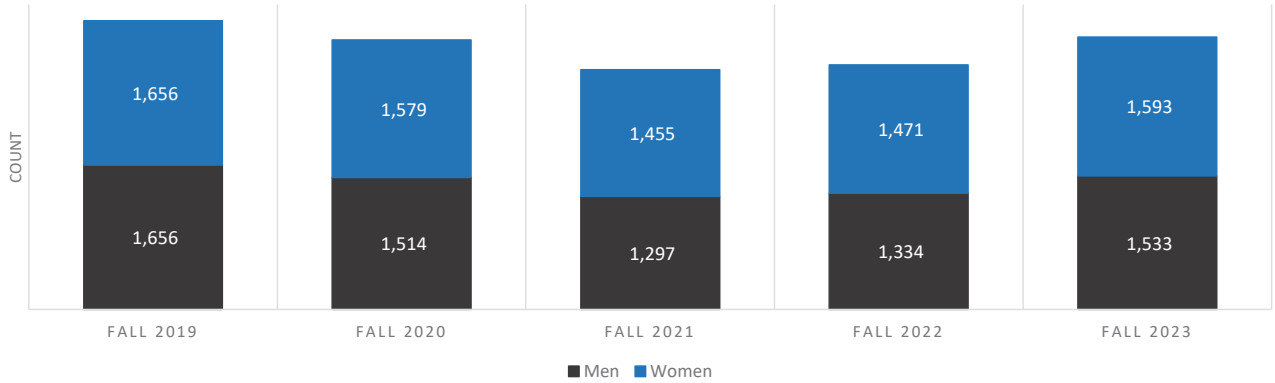

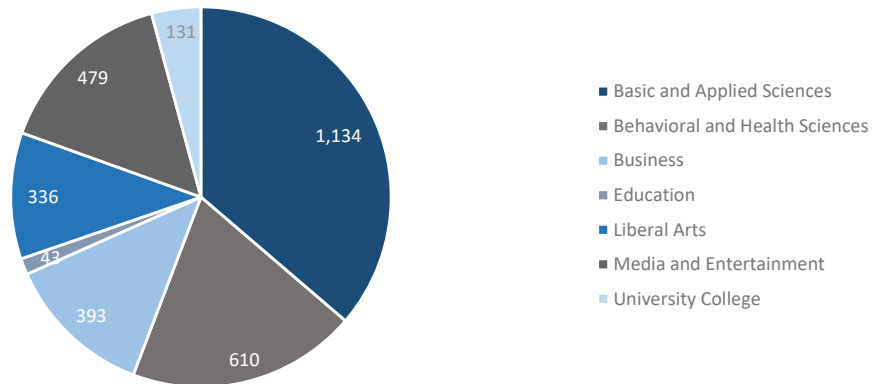

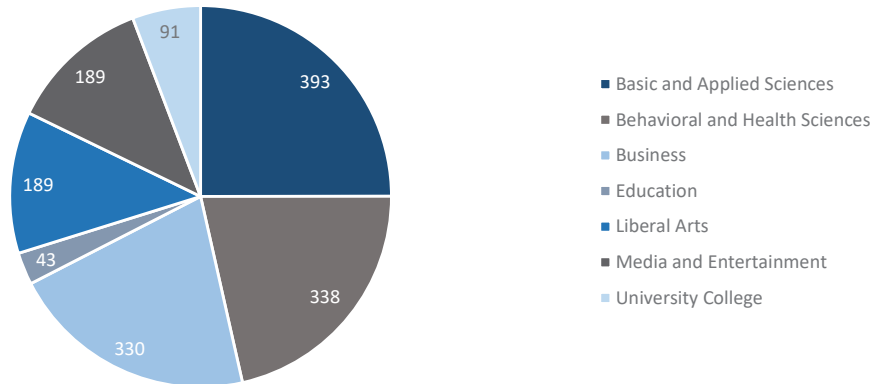

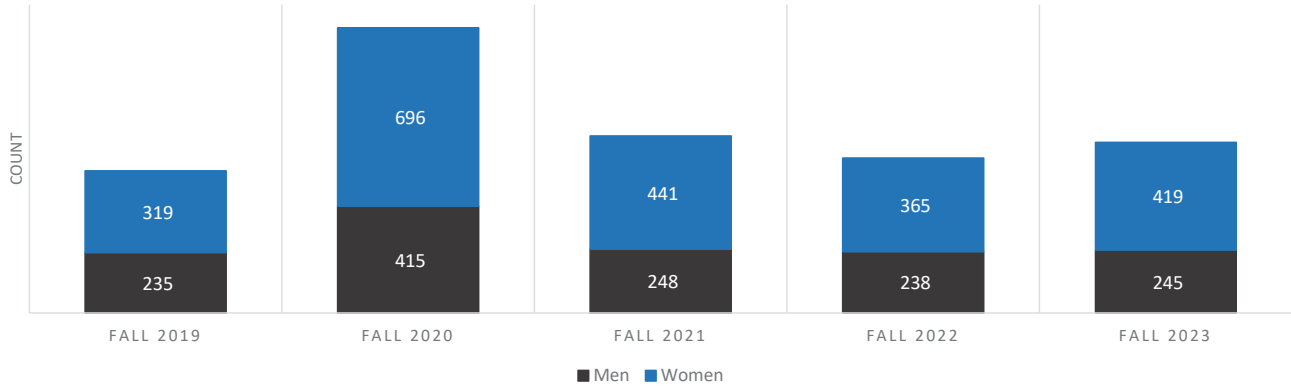

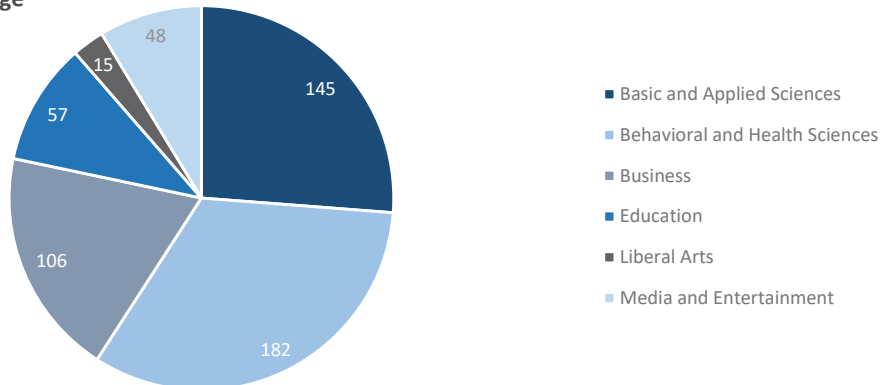

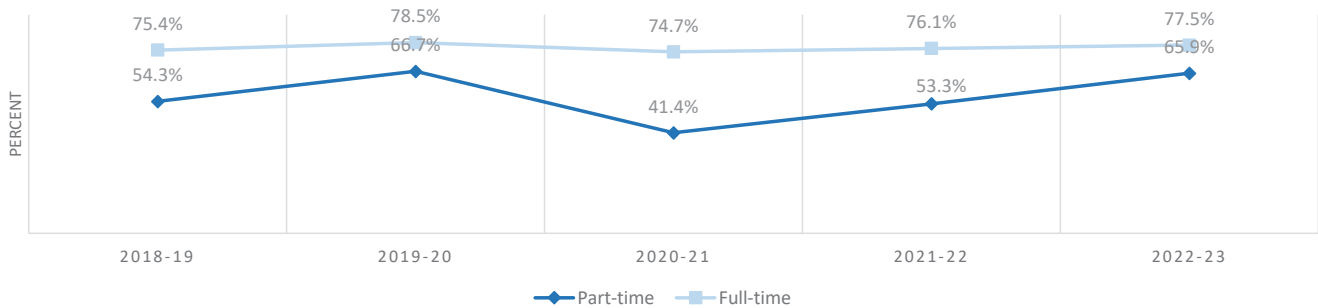

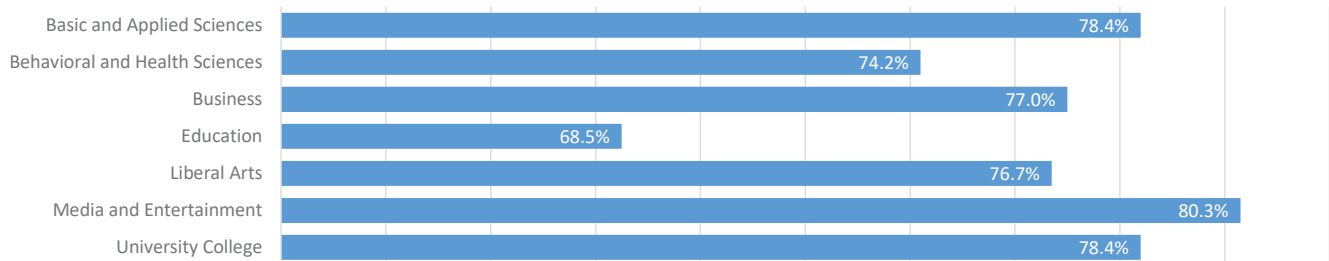

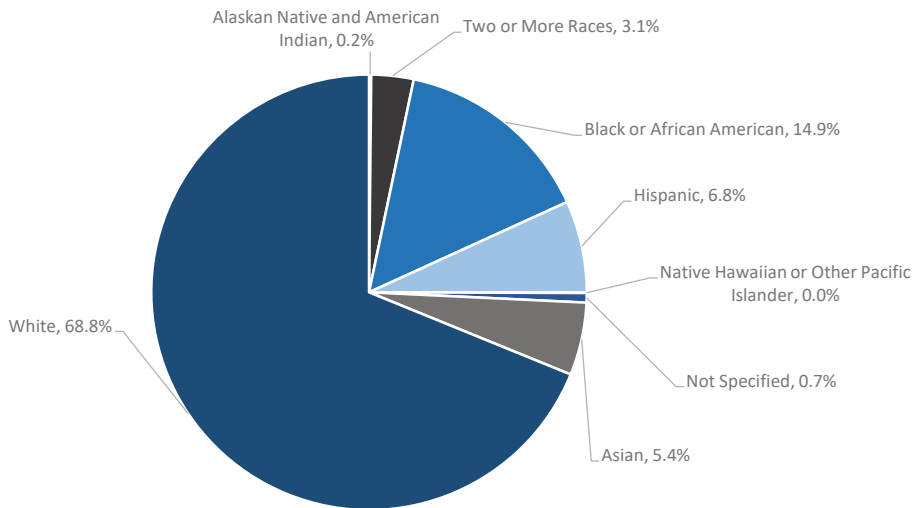

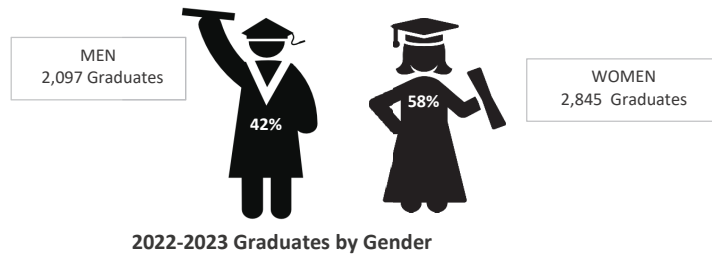

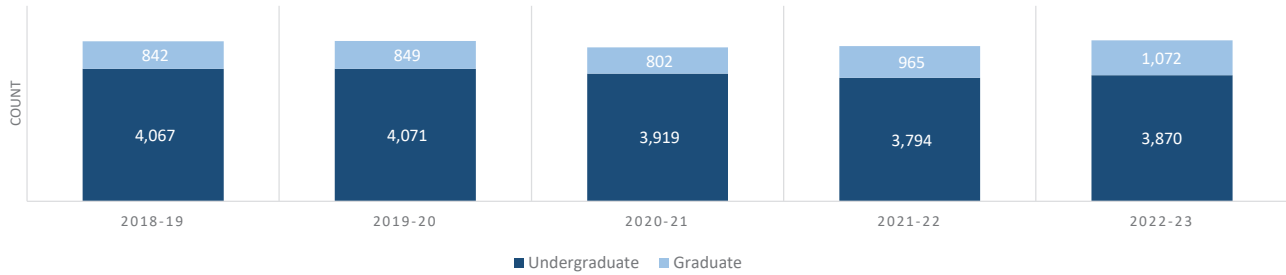

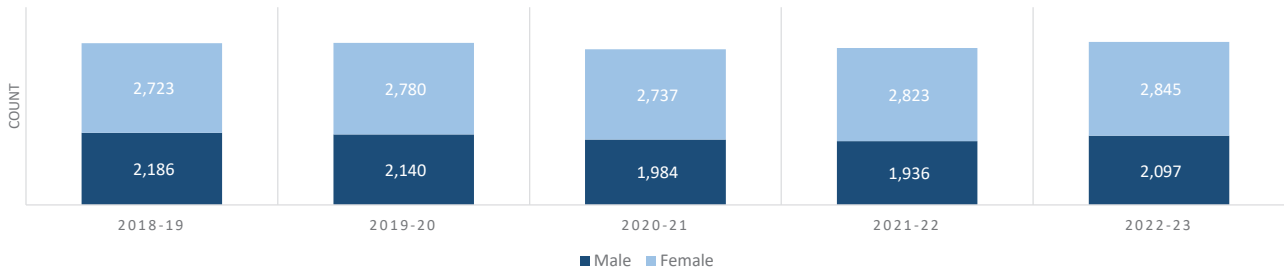

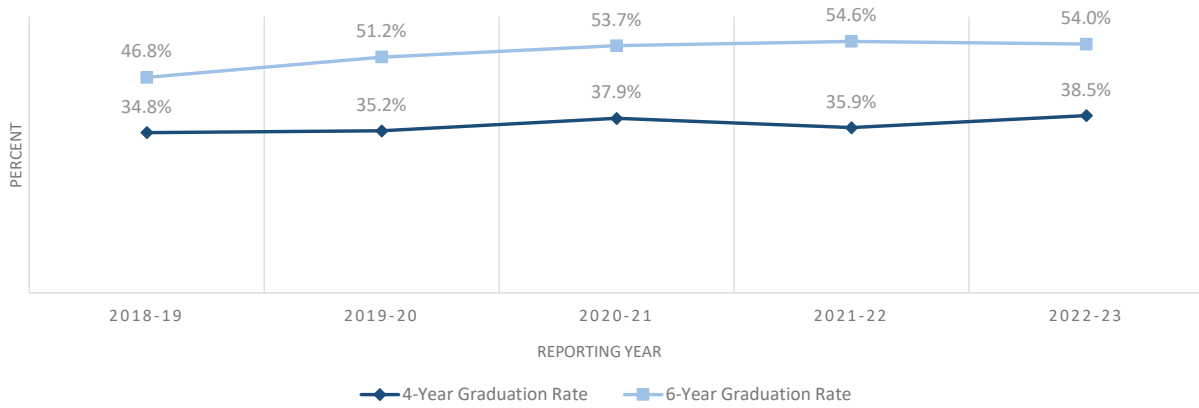

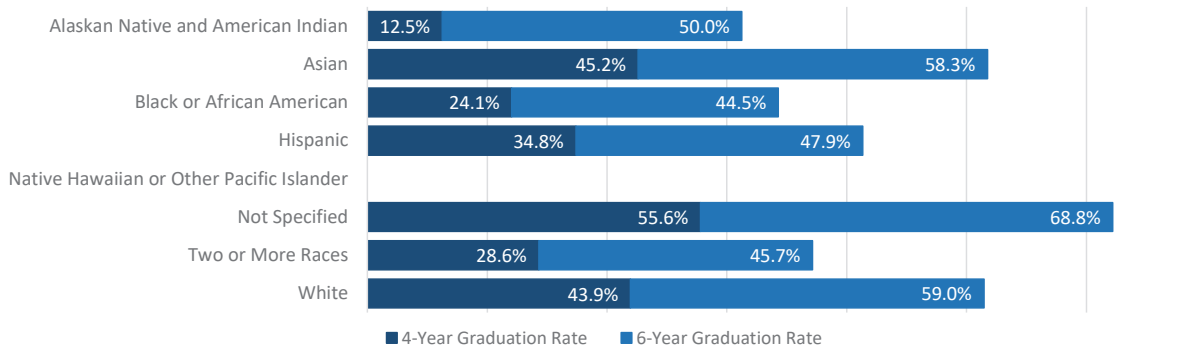
